

## SUMMER 2021 YMCA Camp Reed check-in form

1) Does the camp participant have any of the following symptoms?

Fever of 100.4F or higher (**camper temperature will be obtained on arrival to camp)	
Chills	New loss of taste or smell
Shortness of breath/Difficulty breathing	Sore throat
