Fees: FREE. YMCA family membership entitles you to receive a maximum of 2 hours of child supervision per day free as a membership privilege. Continual usage over the two-hour period will result in possible temporary suspension of services. *Child Watch services are not available for use by Non-Members, Group Members, Day Pass users, or Non-Family YMCA Membership users.*

2. Creating a Successful Experience: _____ (Please initial)

- Child Watch registration forms must be filled out completely for each child using Child Watch services. These forms shall be updated when you have new information, or when requested by staff. Separate registration forms need to be kept on file at every location you visit.
- You must always remain in the YMCA facility while your children are signed into the Child Watch Area. You must indicate the specific location of your whereabouts in our sign in book.
- You must sign child(ren) in/out.
- Please fill out a name tag for each of your children on every visit.
- Due to Child Watch protocols staff cannot feed children or change diapers. If feeding or changing is needed, staff will locate you to take care of the child's needs.
- All allergies or conditions that require special treatment or care should be noted on the Registration Form under Comments and discussed with check-in staff at each visit to Child Watch. Also discuss the proper way to assist your child in the event they require it.
- Child Watch staff cannot be responsible for monitoring potty-training. Toddlers who are potty-training must be appropriately dressed in a pull-up diaper or underwear. If the child needs help, staff will locate you to assist them.
- Shoes must be always worn. We make exceptions for non-walking infants.
- Children's personal items cannot be allowed into the Child Watch area (ex: toys from home, basketballs, sunglasses). Staff may make some exceptions for security items for new children, and for infant care items (ex: pacifiers, blankets, etc.). Please make sure these items have a name tag on them.
- No food is allowed in the Child Watch area. You may provide pre-made bottles for infants. Bottles will be stored out of reach from other children. If able, staff will hold and feed infants.
