



2026 Camp Reed Staff Application Instructions

YMCA Camp Reed is now accepting applications for 2026 SUMMER STAFF! Positions at Camp Reed are full time, seven days a week from approximately **June 14 – Aug 15**. Pre-season training is required, and post season program work may be available for summer staff remaining in Spokane.

****Applicants must be 18 years old by June 14, 2026, to be eligible for employment in Summer of 2026.**

INTERVIEWS – Interviews will be scheduled as applications are received and will be held in December & January either in person at the YMCA Corporate Office OR via Zoom. Note: all interviews for returning applicants will be held on Zoom. **All hiring decisions will be made by mid-February.**

APPLICATION DEADLINE: Monday, January 5, 2026. Late applications will not be accepted.

****SUMMER TIME OFF & SCHEDULING:** Staff are expected to work a **minimum of six (6) full weeks of camp** and are required to attend **Staff Week (June 14-19)**. Requests for time off during the summer are considered on a **first come, first served basis**, with a limited number of staff approved per week.

All time off requests must be submitted on your Staff Acceptance Form (if you are offered a position). Requests are **not guaranteed**, so please plan summer commitments accordingly.
